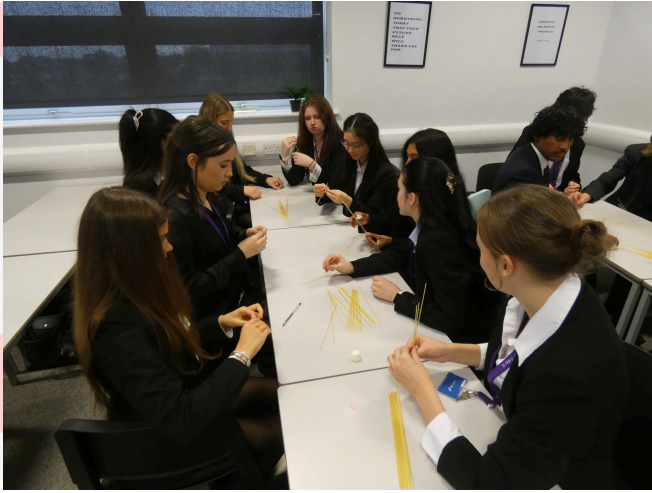


Student Leadership Scheme



As the most senior students in the school, Sixth Form students are expected to act as positive role models for the whole school community, guiding younger students both academically and pastorally. This includes demonstrating high standards in their own conduct and studies, as well as supporting others to do the same.

Sixth Formers are encouraged to take an active part in school life through the Student Leadership Scheme, where they are entrusted with meaningful roles across a range of activities, such as running extra-curricular clubs, acting as classroom assistants, serving as academic or pastoral mentors, helping to organise whole-school events and supporting staff in different areas of the school.

Each student is expected to complete one hour of Student Leadership each week, providing service to others in the school community. This may involve supporting a subject department or contributing to wider whole-school initiatives, helping students to develop responsibility, confidence and a strong sense of service.
