EXAMPLE 1

Secure 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can consider how this parable can be used to challenge discrimination. • I can consider what humility, generosity, reconciliation, repentance would look like, sound like, smell like, taste like and feel like.
Greater Depth 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can discuss and debate the question, 'Is it always possible to forgive and forget?' and can justify my reasons clearly.

A meaningful performance, well done.

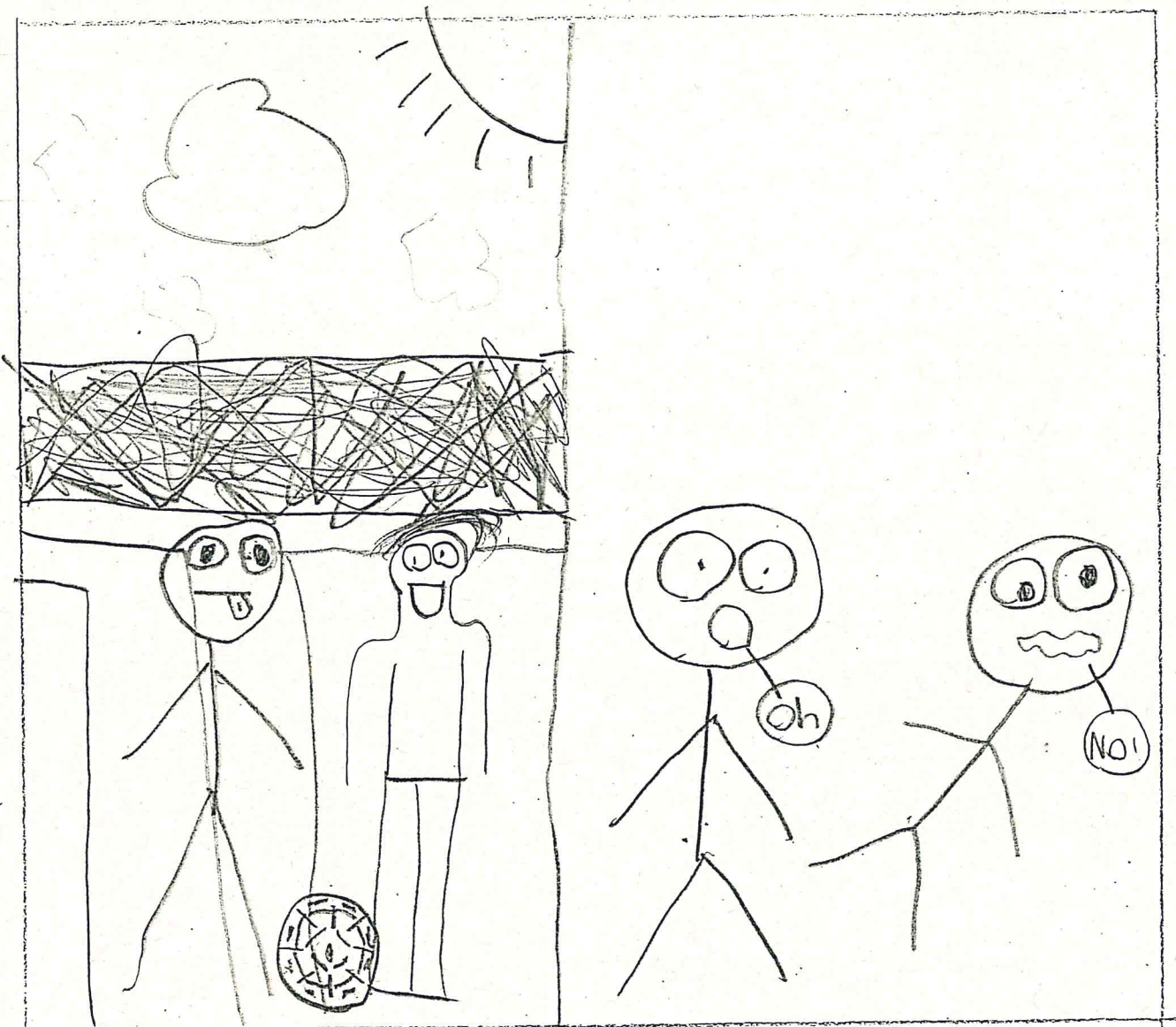
