Forget-me-not knitting pattern

Knitting Needles Size 3mm or No 11

Use double knitting wool, blue for the petals and white or cream for the centre of the flower. If you wish you can sew a black dot in the centre. Alternatively use a button or felt for the centre of the flower.

Petals - Blue - Cast on 6 stitches

Row 15

Row 1

Row 1	Knit to end of row
Row 2	Knit to end of row
Row 3	Knit 1, make 1 and knit to end of row
Row 4	Knit to end of row
Row 5	Knit 1, make 1 and knit to end of row (8 stitches)
Rows 6, 7, 8	Knit
Row 9	Knit 1, Knit 2 together through the back loop, knit to end of row
Row 10	Knit to end of row
Row 11	Knit 1, Knit 2 together through the back loop, knit to end of row
Row 12	Knit to end of row (6 stitches)
Row 13	Cast off 3 stitches, knit to end of row (3 stitches)
Row 14	Knit to end of row

Cast on 3 stitches, knit to end of row

(You need to make 5 petals by repeating the pattern above) Repeat Rows 2-15, 3 more times, then repeat rows 2-14 again. Cast off leaving about 7" (approx. 18cm) of wool.

Knit to end of row

Middle of flower (White/Cream) - Cast on 3 stitches

Row 2	Knit to end of row
Row 3	Knit 1, make 1, make 1, knit 1 (5 stitches)
Row 4	Knit to end of row
Rows 5, 6, 7, 8	Knit
Row 9	Knit 1, knit 2 together, knit 2 together (3 stitches)
Row 10	Knit to end of row
Row 11	Knit to end of row
Row 12	Cast off



Making up the forget-me-not

To make up the flower – take the blue petals and thread the wool (which you cut at 7") along the straight edge of the main part and pull tightly and secure.









Sew white/cream middle into centre and pull tightly and secure.





Draw this up, then sew into the centre
