The Convent of Jesus and Mary Language College offers each student a 16-19 Study Programme based on their prior attainment and designed to meet individual educational needs.

All students who have not achieved a grade 4 (previously a C) in GCSE Maths and English Language by the end of Key Stage 4 is required to continue to study those subjects. The school provides bespoke classes for students who need to retake.

All students are given the opportunity to follow a course that:

- Provides progression to a level higher than that of their prior attainment
- Includes qualifications that are clearly linked to suitable progression opportunities in training, employment or higher levels of education
- Requires students to work towards GCSE 4-9 grades in Maths and English by attending two weekly lessons to prepare them for the November and June exam seasons.
- Allows for relevant and meaningful work experience related to the vocational area of the Study Programme, which develops employability skills and/or creates potential employment options
- Includes other activities unrelated to qualifications that develop the skills, attitudes and confidence needed for progression

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
