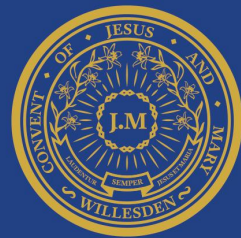


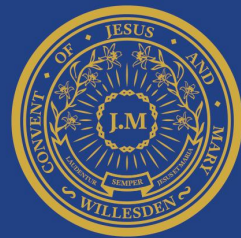

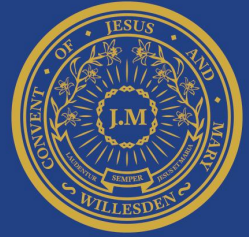

# Why are we here?

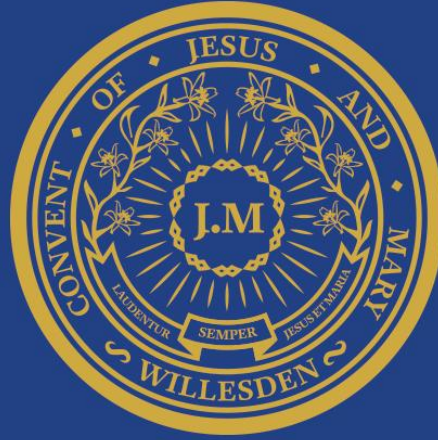


- To learn more about the subjects on offer in our 6th Form

# 6th Form Pathways



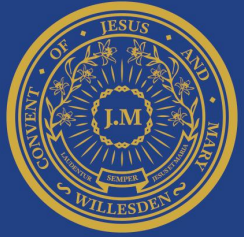
Level	Duration	Entry Requirements	Destination

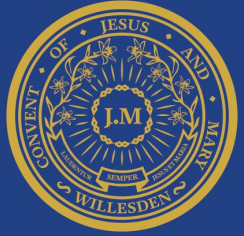

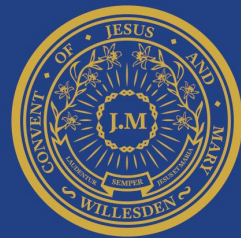
# We want you all to stay

- Our 6th form is like our very own 'Finishing School'







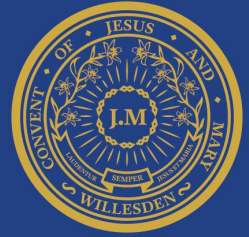
# Curriculum and course offer

- For students not yet ready for A levels there is a one year level 2 vocational programme





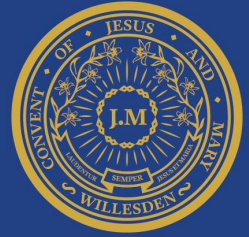
# Our 6th Form Results are amazing!



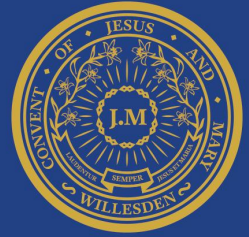
- 99% pass rate

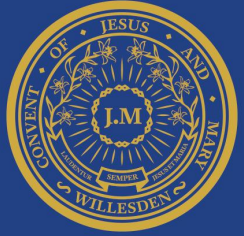
# Research School

- The EPQ or Extended Project Qualification and is equivalent of an extra half A level and 28 UCAS points

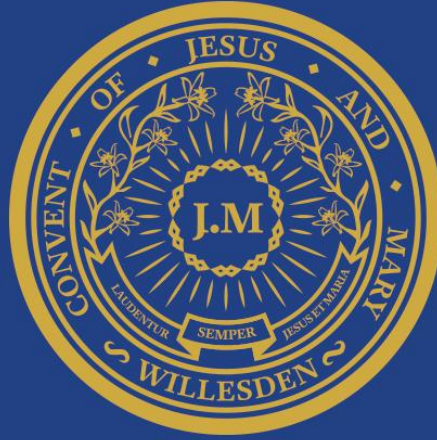

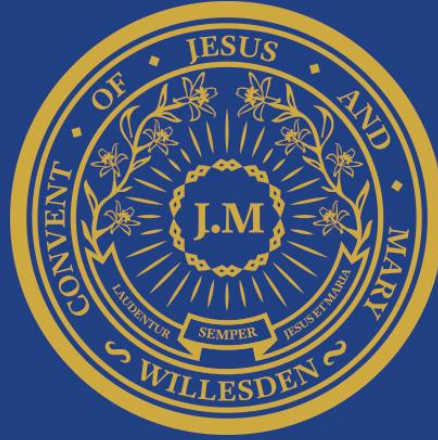
