### Why are we here?




- To learn more about the subjects on offer in our 6th Form

| Level          | Duration | Entry Requirements                                    | Destination               |
|----------------|----------|---|---------------------------|
| Advanced Level | 2 Years  | 5 Grade 5 and above GCSEs including English and Maths | University/Apprenticeship |
| Level 3        | 2 Years  | 5 Grade 4 and above GCSEs including English and Maths | University/Apprenticeship |
| Level 2        | 1 Year   |   | Level 3 study             |

   Qualification and is equivalent of an extra half A level and 28 UCAS points






