	Futures Programme		
	The futures programme is a bespoke offer for a small number of students that are not ready to progress into further education at the end of year 11. It was designed and continues to adapt to meet the needs of a bespoke group annually to reduce the likelihood of NEETs. With the support of Local Authority, we provide (depending on need) supported apprenticeships/work experience, job coaching, Functional Skills in Maths and English and BTEC qualifications.  The intention of this programme is to increase confidence, gaining qualifications and increasing their resilience to prepare students to progress onto the next stage of their education or into employment.

## Maths in Enterprise

The students are currently following a KS3 scheme of work and this is taught through 4 hours a week of Maths lessons. Most students will be entered for their Maths GCSE qualification alongside Entry level qualifications where appropriate.

## **English in Enterprise**

The students are focusing on key English skills particularly their written English through a focus on vocabulary and sentence structures and their reading and inference skills. Students are working towards their entry level Step Up to English qualification as well as their eventual English language GCSE. They are taught 5 times per week.

## **ASDAN**

The students will be following the Personal and Social Development qualification, working towards an Entry level 3 Certificate. The Personal and Social Development (PSD) qualification offers imaginative ways of supporting young people in:

- becoming confident individuals who are physically, emotionally and socially healthy
- being responsible citizens who make a positive contribution to society and embrace change
- managing risk together with their own wellbeing.

Evidence towards their qualification will take many forms, for example: evaluations, notebooks; records; posters; leaflets; action plans; tutor observation and witness statements; photographic/digital.
