Deadline is Thursday 31/03 at 3:00pm. Winners will be announced on Friday 01/04



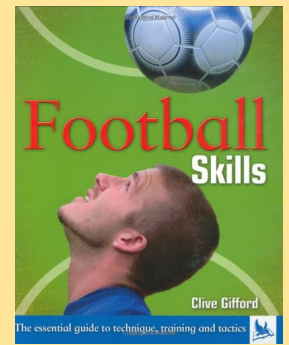
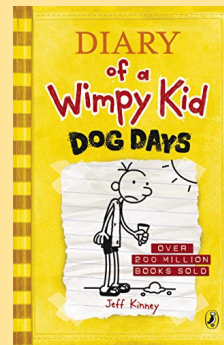
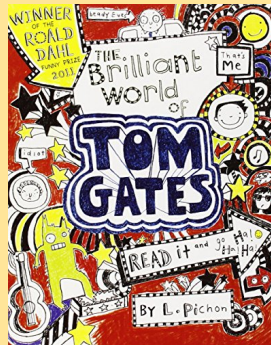
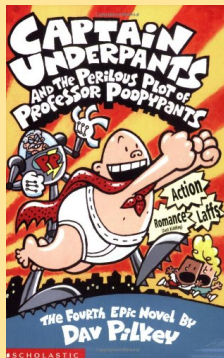
