# Cardinal Wiseman Pupil Saves a Man's Life

Last Friday we received an email from the mother of Chloe McGann, one of our year 11 students, telling us that Chloe saved a young man's life on Thursday night after he was jumped on by several youths, leaving him in a bad condition. Chloe stopped the bus, called for the ambulance and gave CPR. She stayed with the young man until he went to hospital, then she helped police with their enquiries until 3am. She has been nominated for an award by the Young Firefighters for her bravery.

Chloe's mother has asked us to put this in the Friday Letter to encourage other youngsters to do the right thing and learn first aid. Chloe feels the first aid skills she developed at school and with the Fire Service gave her the confidence to deal with this challenging situation.

She also wanted to thank Cardinal Wiseman staff for helping Chloe to become a caring young lady. As she puts it "you all played a part in bringing Chloe up with me".
