<p>Autumn 1 6 weeks</p>	<p><u>Creation</u> Understanding the Christian account of creation through Genesis. Exploring how God sustains the world, and how humans are made in His ‘image and likeness.’ Explaining the concept of original sin through God’s creation of Adam and Eve, and considering the responsibility of mankind in looking after God’s creation (stewardship.)</p>	<p><u>Assessment</u> Tracking Facebook profile Mid term CSI report ‘Who is Jesus?’</p>
<p>Autumn 2 6 weeks</p>	<p><u>Covenant</u> Understanding the Old Testament Covenant relationships between God and the Prophets; Noah, Abraham, Moses. Leading to an understanding of Jesus as the ‘New Covenant.’ Exploring ‘Covenant’ from both the Jewish and Christian perspectives.</p>	<p><u>Assessment</u> Tracking ABCD questions on Old Testament prophets. Mid term A comparison of ‘Evan Almighty’ and ‘Noah’s Ark.’</p>
<p>Spring 1 5 weeks</p>	<p><u>Crime and Punishment.</u> Understanding key principles of Crime and Punishment from a Christian and Islamic perspective, including the need for Law, theories of punishment, Capital Punishment, Justice and Peace and attitudes to drugs and alcohol.</p>	<p><u>Assessment</u> Tracking ABCD questions Mid term Group Presentation on the Theories of punishment.</p>
<p>Spring 2 7 weeks</p>	<p><u>Sex and Relationships</u> Understanding the Catholic teaching about sex and relationships as discussed through JP II ‘theology of the body.’ Understanding contraception methods, abortion and sexual health within a Catholic context and exploring positive relationships, peer pressure and understanding different emotions through the use of ‘real’ scenarios.</p>	<p><u>Assessment</u> Tracking Evaluative essay on sex and relationships. Mid term Leaflet on different contraceptive methods.</p>
<p>Summer 1 & 2 13 weeks</p>	<p><u>An introduction to Judaism.</u> Understanding fundamental practices of Judaism, including Jewish identity (Orthodox and Reform Judaism), the celebration of Bah/Bat Mitzvah, Food Laws, the Torah, The festivals of Chanukah and Passover and the Synagogue. <i>Assessment – Judaism Assessment</i></p>	<p><u>Assessment</u> Tracking ABCD questions Mid term Design a Synagogue.</p>
