

Excellent Progress for Students at Cardinal Wiseman Catholic School



Students at Cardinal Wiseman Catholic School are celebrating another fantastic year of results as the school goes from strength to strength.

The Progress 8 Score is a positive result of 0.14, which is significantly above national average meaning that students make better rates of progress at our school than those nationally.

The top achieving students were Mugthalanta Allet, Connie Luong and Nicole Cullen who all achieved strong grades (9-5) in ten subjects including the very best grade of 9. Mugthalanta and Connie are both planning on going to Sutton Coldfield Grammar School for Girls.



The percentage of students achieving a strong pass in English and Maths have also both improved.

59 students in our current Year 10 group took their RE exam one year early and achieved a strong 9-5 pass with 6 students achieving the top grade 9.
