Prophet Elijah

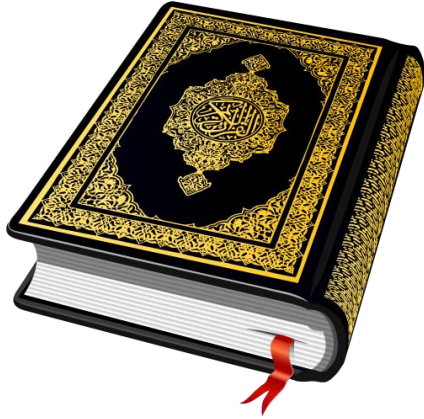
- People were worshipping false Gods - Baal

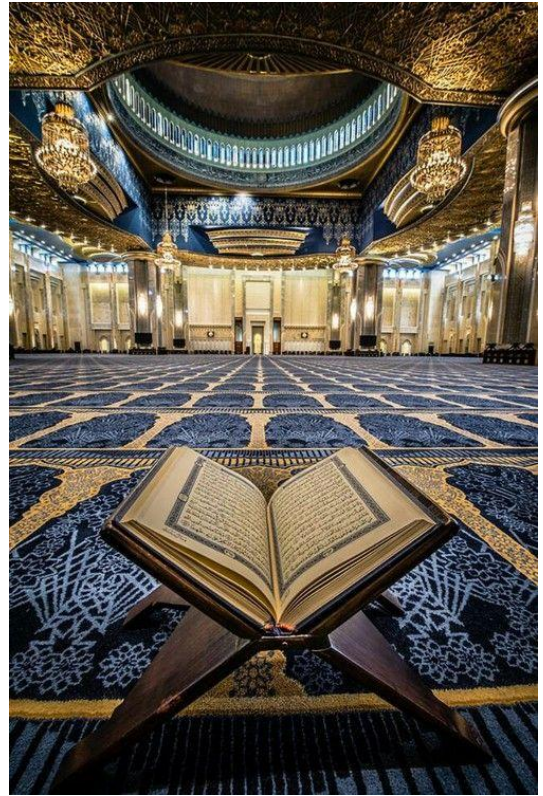


Appendix 6 – Sacred Texts in Different Religions
