Hertfordshire Library

Ready Reads: We select, you collect. A new way to borrow books from selected libraries. Order books for yourself and other family members, all on the same form. You'll need to be a library member to use this service.

Step 1 - you order Tell us what you want to read and which participating library you want to collect from. You won't be able to request specific authors or titles. If you can't use the online request form, you can ring us on 0300 123 4049.

Step 2 - we select We'll select a pack of books based on your choices and the stock available. We'll do our best to find books you will enjoy.

Step 3 - you collect We'll contact you when your pack is ready for collection from your selected library. Please bring your own bag and pick them up from the library door. We'll issue the books to your card, so all you have to do is collect them. No other access to the library will be possible



Ready Reads book packs There are **6 books** in each adult and teen Ready Reads pack and **12 books** in each children's Ready Reads pack.

Adults You can order one fiction and one non-fiction pack per adult at a time. If you need large print, a selection of packs is also available.
