

When are instrumental lessons starting?

Instrumental lessons are scheduled to start at the beginning of the Summer Term.

How do I sign up?

Log into Parent Pay and pay for the lessons. The Music Department will be notified of your payment and will contact you about which instrument you want to learn. Your name will then be added to the instrumental timetable.

How much do lessons cost?

10 lessons across the whole term costs £50.

How long do lessons last? Lessons last for 30 minutes and take place during the school day.



Anything else I need to know? Spaces for instrumental lessons are limited so try to secure your place as soon as possible. Once the school receives payment, your place is secured.

If you have difficulties using Parent Pay, please speak to the Music Department about alternative payment methods.

Due to covid protocols, the instrumental teacher will collect and return you to your bubble following the lesson.
