Reception Tasks

- This week we will be looking at the language more and less
- We will be saying what is one more than a given number and then finding that number for example 1 more than 1 is?
- We will then be looking at 1 less which means the children will need to take 1 away for example 1 less than 2 is the same as 2-1.
- In your pack you will have a number line to help you to jump forwards and backwards on the number line.
- In your pack you will have some Numicon to play with.
 Make a number line with the Numicon. Can you see a pattern? Odd number then even number, why are they different. Find one more and one less than a given Numicon.
