

#### Madagascar Rainforest:

- It it the one place on Earth that homes Lemurs and many one of a kind animals and plants.
- Madagascar is home to almost 25,000 species of wild animals, with a lot of them being endangered.
- The rainforest covers 43,500 Square miles
- The climate is very warm and humid due to the ocean.
- It has 2,000 mm of rain per year.
- It sits at one of the highest elevations, which means it has the dense undergrowth and shorter plants.
