Parent-Teacher Association (PTA)

Forest School

Children have started accessing Forest School from this week. Please ensure your child has their own wellies (preferably with the handles to support them getting them on), as well as warm clothing, hats, scarves and gloves (when required).

Toys from home

We remind all parents that toys from home should not be brought to Nursery with the child. Although some are used to settle the children through the door, they can then cause upset when they go missing and get paint and glue on them. Please encourage children to leave their toys at home or in the car.

Nursery Library

We will be introducing library books from Friday 23rd September. Books will be available for your child to choose and take home every Friday. Please ensure your child's book is returned prior to their session the following Friday.

Book bags are available to buy with the Sue Hedley Nursery school logo on for £2.50. Please ensure books are returned in the same condition they are borrowed.

Nursery opening times

The doors to nursery open:

On a morning at 8:50am till 9:00am and on an afternoon at 12:20pm till 12:30pm, after these times the children have to be signed on the late register at the office, the doors then open again for pick up on a morning at 11:50pm and on an afternoon at 3:20pm for 3.30pm picks ups. Some children are on flexible places and these need to be prior arranged with the head teacher. Please ask if you require further information

Change of clothes

Please ensure all children have a change of clothes hung up on their peg. Sometimes children have accidents and we have a limited supply of clothing. If clothing is borrowed from the nursery please return once washed. As the weather gets wetter we find children sometimes come in from outdoors and Forest School wet or muddy and may need a change, please include a few pairs of socks.

Weekly Voluntary contribution

Each group has a tin where key workers will be accepting £1 on a weekly basis towards Nursery funds. This is a voluntary contribution and will go towards outings, snack, and nursery extras.

October half term

Nursery will be closed after session on Friday 21st October for half term holidays. Nursery will reopen on Monday 31st October.

Halloween

We will be having a Halloween party in nursery on Tuesday 1st November, once children have had the experience of Halloween with their families. Dress up is optional.
