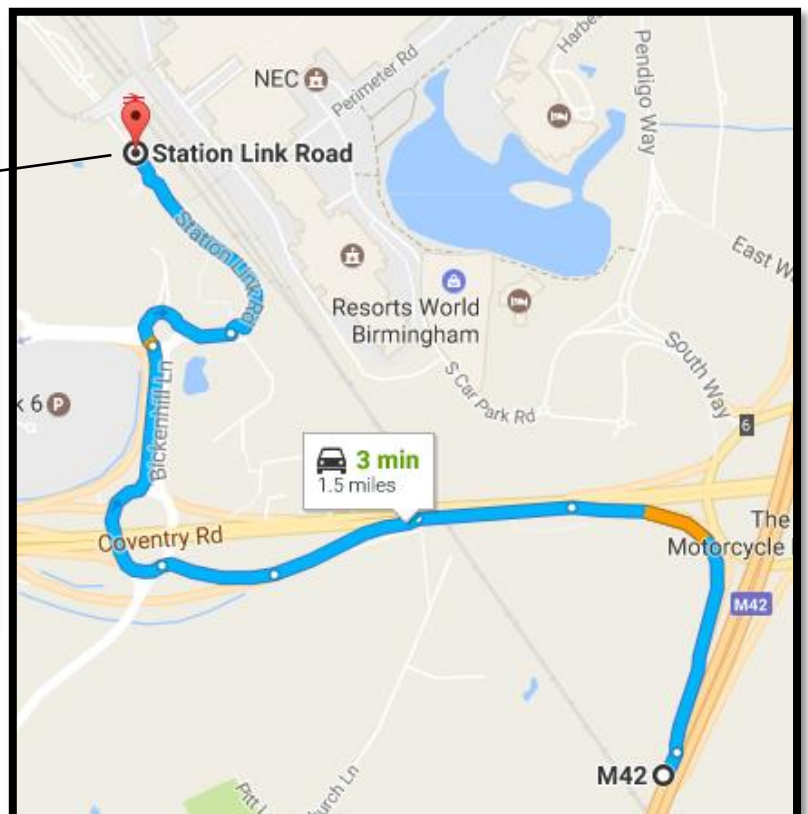
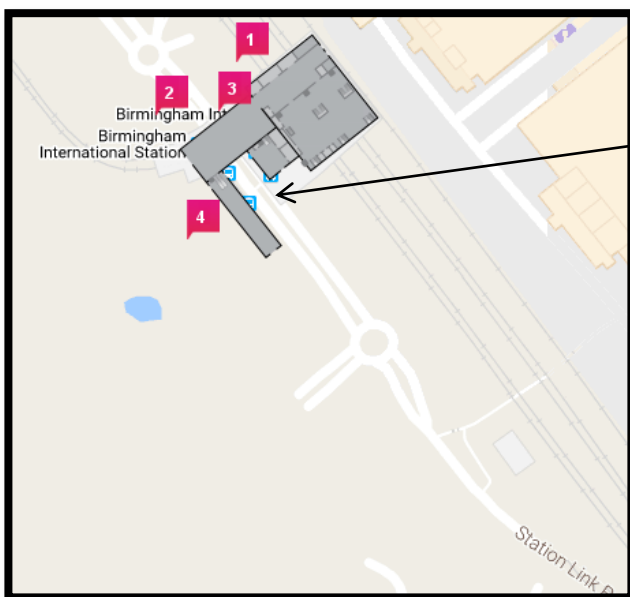




Directions to Birmingham International Rail Station – Barcelona 2017 Drop-off Point

1. Leave Studley on A435 towards M42 junction 3A, through Mappleborough Green.
2. At the M42 3A roundabout, take the 4th exit onto the M42 slip road to M1/Solihull Coventry/London/Warwick/M40/N.E.C. & Airport
3. Merge onto M42 from slip road.
4. Keep left at the fork to stay on M42, follow signs for Solihull/Birmingham (E)/Airport
5. At Junction 6, use the left lane to take the exit towards Airport. This merges onto Coventry Road A45.
6. Almost immediately, take the B4438 exit towards Solihull/Hampton/Bickenhill/Catherine-de-Barnes.
7. Almost immediately, keep right at the fork, following signs for NEC.
8. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Bickenhill Lane B4438
9. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Station Link Rd
10. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on Station Link Rd
11. Car park 3 (Drop-off and pick-up point) is under the bridge on your right.

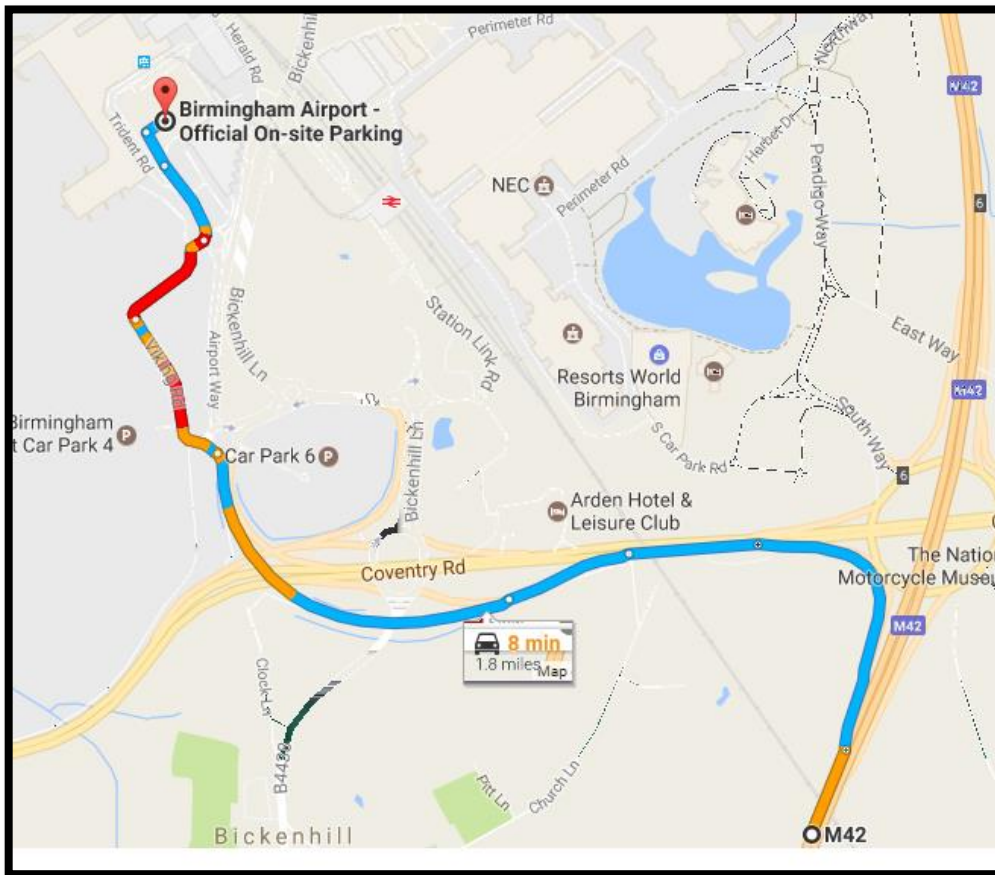




Directions to Birmingham International Airport– Barcelona 2017 Pick-up Point

Follow directions 1-6 as above, then from the B4438 towards Solihull/Hampton/Bickenhill/Catherine-de-Barnes:

7. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Airport.
8. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Viking Rd. Continue straight until your destination, the Drop and Viking Road becomes Hermes Road, then Concorde Road. Car parks 1-3 can be used to pick up students.

Hand Luggage Information for School Groups – Barcelona 2017

Each pupil is allowed ONE piece of hand luggage to measure no larger than 56cm x 40cm x 20cm, and to weigh no more than 10kg, plus ONE bag of duty free shopping from the departure airport.

A small wheelie suitcase or kit bag would be ideal.



Within their hand luggage bag, students should pack a small rucksack/satchel bag to be worn every day containing their essentials. They can wear this around the airport **but staff will ensure this fits inside the hand luggage before boarding the plane.**

- Only take essentials – wear your bulkiest items e.g. jeans, trainers and school hoodie to travel.
- Only pack light garments e.g. T-shirts and shorts. It will be HOT.
- Pack underwear and socks inside any shoes to save space.
- ROLL, don't fold, where possible. This will also save space.

Liquids in Hand Luggage

- Liquids (including creams, pastes and sprays) are restricted to 100ml or less, with each passenger carrying no more than 1 litre of liquids in total.
- Liquids must be placed in individual containers of 100ml or less. Larger containers will not be accepted, even if there is less than 100ml inside.
- Although each individual container does not need to be clear, all of the containers must fit into a clear plastic bag measuring no more than 20cm x 20cm.
- The bag must be able to be closed and sealed - not overfilled or bursting.
- The clear plastic bag will need to be taken out of the hand luggage bag and placed in a tray at airport security.

Here is an example of an acceptable liquids bag:



A sample list of liquids might include:

- toothpaste
- deodorant
- shampoo/conditioner
- shower gel
- insect repellent
- sunscreen
- aftersun cream
- lip balm
- mascara/lip gloss

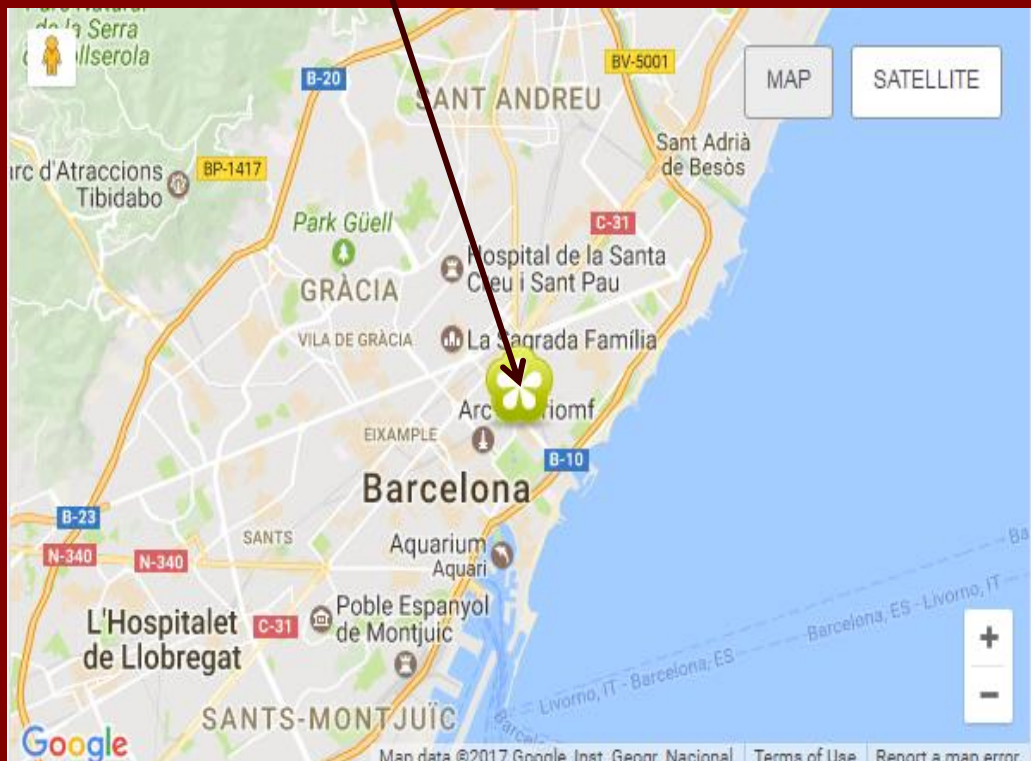

- 03.30 Assemble at Birmingham International Rail Station Drop Off Point. (This is a large space to meet away from the bustle of the airport.)

- 04:00 Party takes free 'Air Rail Link' monorail to Birmingham Airport (2 mins from airport, service on demand).

- 04:40 Check-in at Birmingham Airport

- 06:40 Flight Departure for Barcelona (Monarch flight ZB962)

- 10:30 Flight Arrival in Barcelona El Prat Airport. (Local time)

- 12:30 Arrival at accommodation in Barcelona by coach transfer. Lunch at accommodation (money to be supplied for this meal)

- 16:00 Visit to Camp Nou, FC Barcelona's Stadium

pm: Visit to La Sagrada Familia cathedral

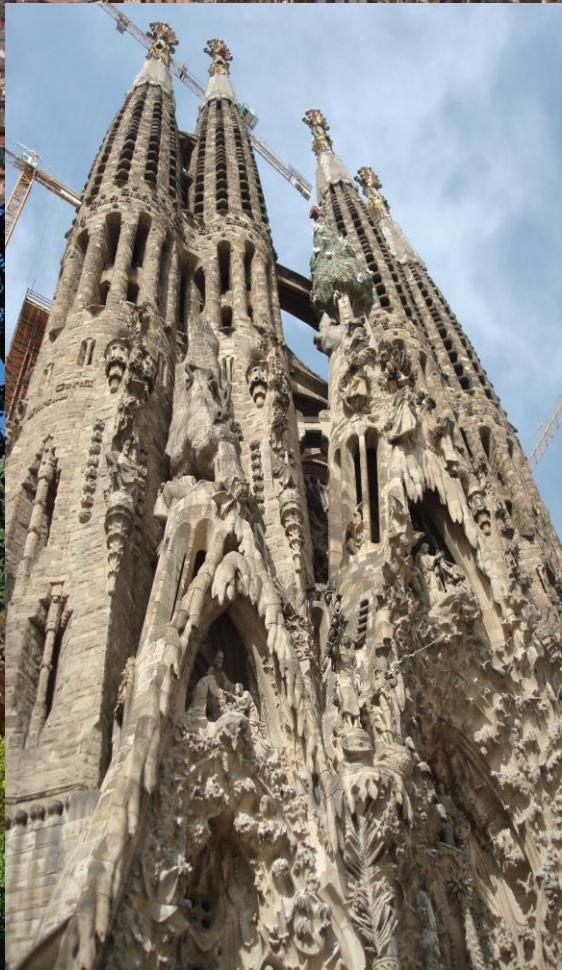
20:30 Evening meal at local restaurant (tbc).

Parents to collect students from the ARRIVAL LOUNGE at Birmingham Airport. Parents must register with staff before leaving with their child.

What will the school need?

- A valid passport
- An EHIC card (European medical insurance)
www.ehic.org.uk
- Medical Form including Overseas Treatment Consent Form.

Documents need to be brought in ASAP to Mrs Morgan.

What do students need to bring with them?

Luggage:

- ONE piece of Hand Luggage measuring no larger than 56 x 40 x 25cm and no heavier than 10kg.

Currently, there is NO HOLD BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE for the visit. This means that all liquids (including shampoo, shower gel etc. will need to be decanted into clear bottles in a clear plastic bag of no more than 100ml per bottle).

Please see separate document for hand luggage guidance.

What the students need to bring with them?

- Pocket money – recommend approx. €75 to include lunch each day and metro tickets (approx. 10€). Do bring a few pounds to spend on journey/on plane. Money is at own risk.
- Clothes – see kit list
- Travel adaptors 3 pin to 2 pin.
- Studley Hoodie – **MUST BE WORN TO AIRPORT**
- Can bring mobile phones and games but at owners risk ... the school is not responsible for the loss of these.

Kit List

Educational Visit to Barcelona (guidance only)

- Personal medication (labelled with name and dosage)
- Travel sickness tablets (if required)
- High SPF sunscreen
- Spending money
- Small backpack for day-trips (to fit inside hand luggage)
- Torch
- Washbag (liquids to be packed separately – see guidance)
- Other personal toiletries including sanitary towels.
- A spare towel for the beach.
- Plastic bags for laundry
- Spanish/English dictionary (optional but useful!)
- **At least 4 T-shirts**
- 1 pair of jeans/trousers
- 2-3 shorts
- Socks and underwear
- Pyjamas/nightwear
- Indoor shoes to wear round accommodation (flip flops or pumps)
- Comfortable trainers/shoes to walk in ALL DAY.

Safety Reminders

- Barcelona is notorious for pickpockets. We cannot stress enough the importance of being vigilant and taking on board these safety tips.
 - 1) Do not bring unnecessary valuables with you.
 - 2) Do not get money/valuables out in the street.
 - 3) Be careful with your choice of bag/rucksack. External zips are an easy target.
 - 4) Please make sure you are always in sight of a member of staff when in Barcelona. You will be able to wander in groups at Port Aventura.
 - 5) Ignore anybody you do not know trying to attract your attention/distract you.
 - 6) Do not join in street scams which target tourists.
