Uniform Standards

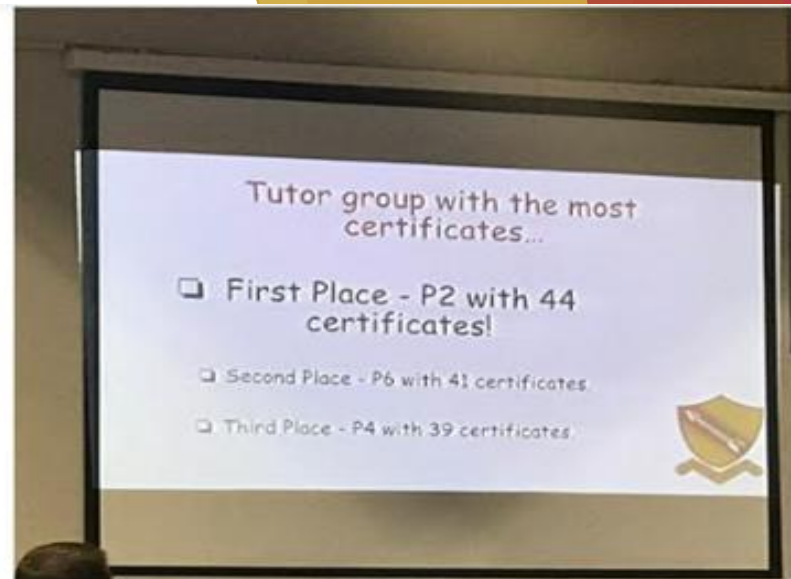

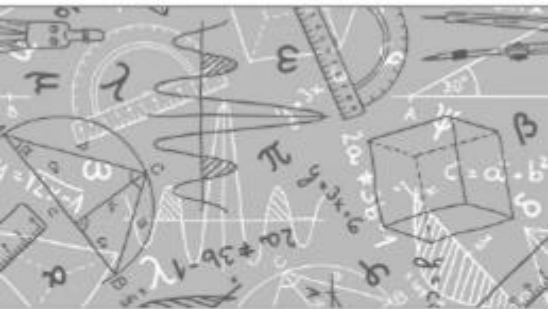
