## SUCCESS

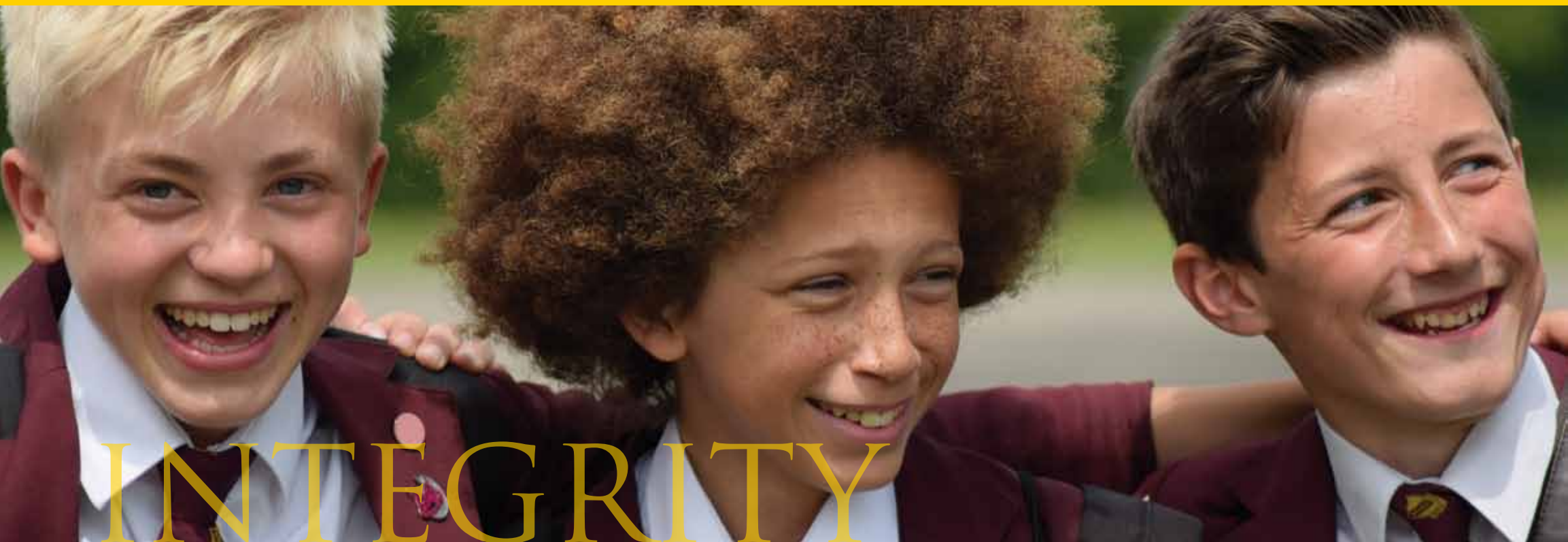
