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STUDLEY HIGH SCHOOL: AIMS & VALUES

- We believe in **high expectations** for all members of the school community.
- We believe pupils should develop an enthusiasm for learning and that they should **willingly** seek to gain knowledge and understanding about the world around them.
- We believe students should be provided with the guidance, information and resources necessary to **help** them learn.
- We believe it is our duty to **teach** students the skills necessary for effective and efficient learning.
- We believe that pupils should **develop a sense of pride** in themselves and their school, so that they always aim to achieve the highest possible standards of work in all subjects.
- We believe that we should create an environment that **fosters** the personal qualities, skills and **self-confidence** necessary for success in their chosen career and personal life.
- We believe in developing high levels of **self-esteem, self-confidence, and resilience in our students.**
- We believe that students should develop a sense of **respect** for themselves, other individuals and their environment.
- We believe in promoting high levels of **wellbeing** for all.
- We believe in demonstrating the **Studley Values** in the pupils' day to day experience.
- We believe students can accept responsibility for their own behaviour.
- We believe in restorative interventions that support students reflecting on decisions they have made and helps develop effective character and learning habits.
- We believe that behaviour and conduct that goes 'above and beyond' should be acknowledged and rewarded.
- **We believe every student can meet our expectations.**
- We celebrate when students demonstrate evidence of the following key values: Independence, resilience, aspiration, creativity, adaptability, charitable, selflessness and maturity.

We believe that these aims are more likely to be achieved if there is a togetherness/partnership between the school, the students and the parents based on **mutual trust, respect and understanding**. These aims and values are what make Studley High School unique: they make up the Studley High School 'DNA'.





HOME-SCHOOL RELATIONSHIP AGREEMENT

To achieve success, and to support the school's aims & values, students should:

- Attend school punctually and with minimum absence.
- Bring necessary equipment and books including pens and pencils to all lessons.
- Complete classwork and homework to the best of their ability.
- Ask teachers for help when they have problems with their work.
- Behave responsibly at all times.
- Adhere to the school rules.
- Wear school uniform as is expected.
- Be polite and respectful to others.
- Conduct themselves at all times in such a way as to enhance the school's reputation within the community.

To contribute to their child's success, and support the school's aims & values, parents/carers should:

- Ensure that children attend school punctually and with minimum absence.
- Ensure that children are prepared for learning by equipping them with correct equipment, required books and PE kit OR discussing with the school where this is not possible.
- Ensure that children complete all homework set to the best of their ability and in reasonable working conditions.
- Work constructively and cooperatively with the school to resolve any concerns about attendance, punctuality, behaviour or work.
- Be familiar with the rules and expectations of Studley High School and support children to meet them.
- Monitor rewards and sanctions applied to their child through the use of Class Charts and discuss any worrying patterns of behaviour.
- Ensure that children are properly dressed in the correct school uniform.
- Attend Parents' Evenings and meetings.
- Inform the school of any concerns or problems which might affect their child's progress.
- Take an interest in Studley High School life and celebrate the successes of their child.
- Trust that Studley High School is always acting in the best interests of the school community and the individual student.

To allow Studley High School to be a positive environment for your child, we ask parents/carers to pay particular attention to...

- **Expectations regarding mobile phone use within school** – We do **NOT** allow students to have their mobile phone in their possession in any form during the school day.
- **Expectations regarding punctuality** – Students should arrive at school by **8.25am**. Please support your child to arrive on time.
- **Expectations regarding uniform** – The uniform policy is very clear. Please support your child to meet these standards, paying particular attention to the expectations regarding jewellery, footwear and make-up/hair.
- **The Studley High School Behaviour (inc anti-bullying) policy** – Full details of the school's Behaviour policy can be found on the website. Bullying and retaliation to bullying will never be tolerated. If a student feels that they are being bullied, they must tell a member of staff.
- **The Studley High School systems of communication** – Ensure you have logged into the ClassCharts and use regularly to monitor behaviour and homework. Record your child's username and password to avoid issues later in the year.
