Other Information

Edward Peake school is currently undergoing extensive building works so some of the travel issues that the school is currently facing (e.g. construction traffic, restricted access) are of a temporary nature. This travel plan has been put together in support of planning application CB/15/00369/FULL. As of November 2015, the school are committed to the Bike It programme, working with Sustrans.
