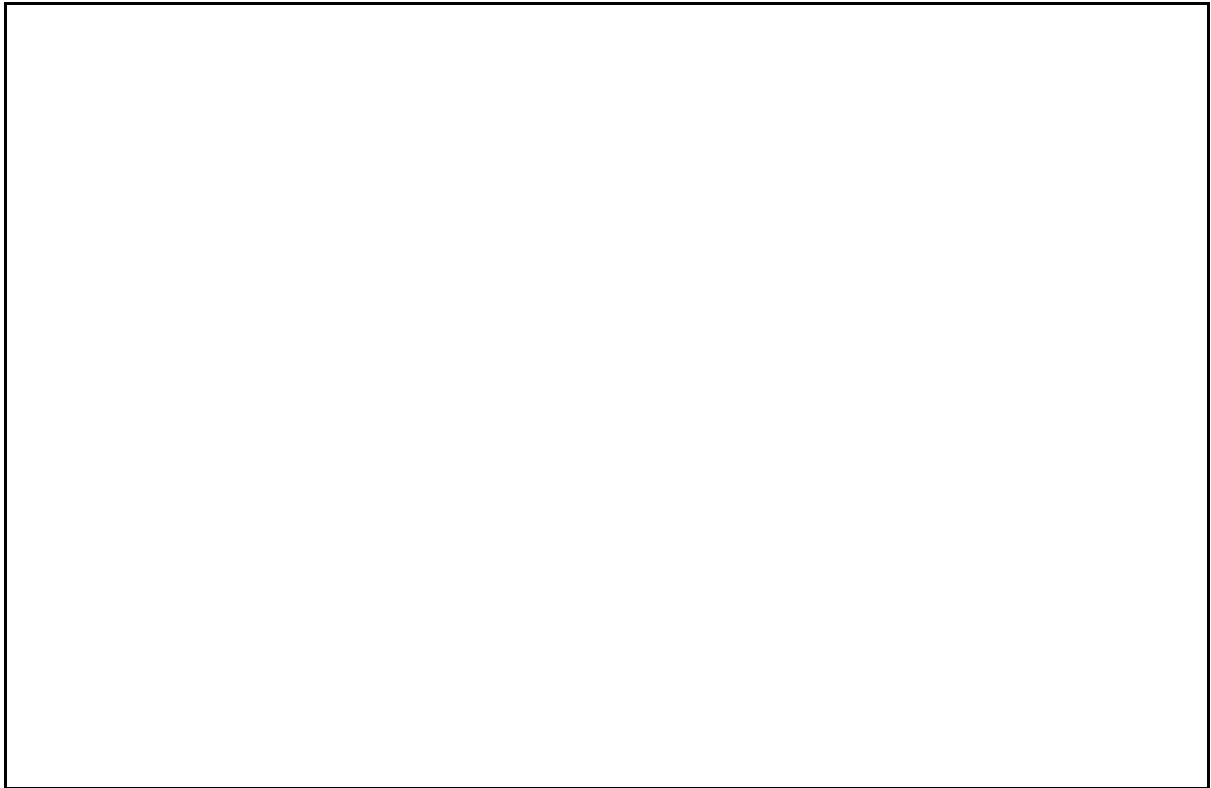

In this booklet you need to create a information booklet about a historical event in the country of your choice.


Your booklet needs to contain the following:

You can create a collage, you can create maps, you can write descriptions/ song/ poems, use graphs. It is your choice as to how you present the information.

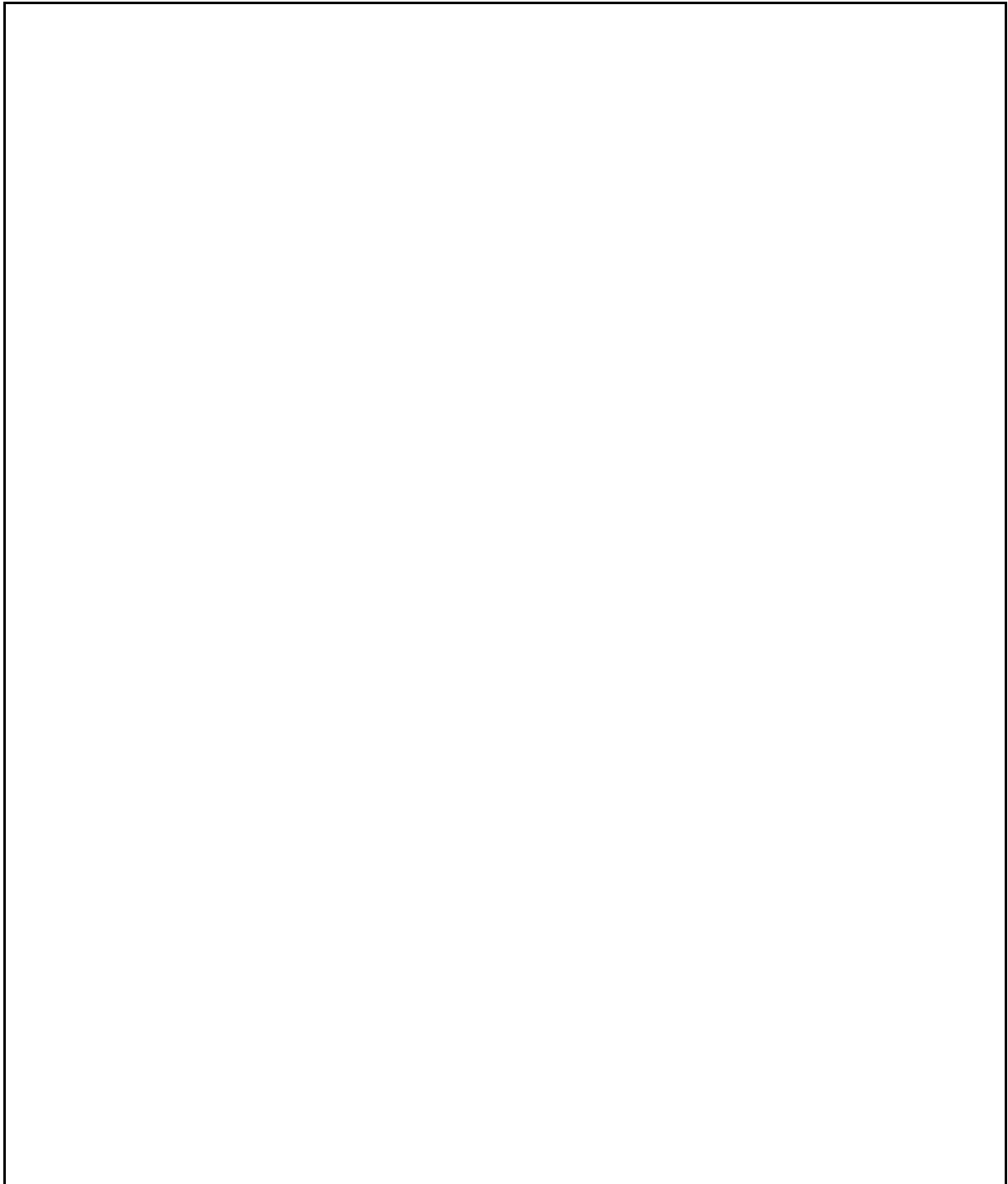
Introduction to the event


Where was the event?

Create a map which shows the locations of the event.




What caused the event?


Who was involved in the event?


What happened during the event?




