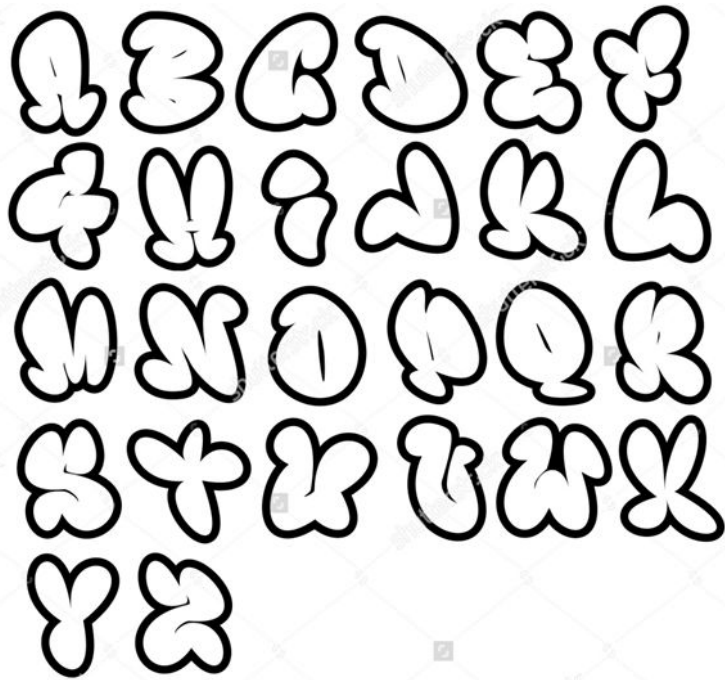
LO: to design a shoe using graffiti art techniques.

# STREET ART

**LO: to complete an observation drawing of fruit.**

**TASK:** You will need an A4 piece of paper, a drawing pencil, rubber and sharpener.

Layout some fruit (3-5 pieces), make sure it is overlapped with fruit in front of each other like the fruit we have drawn in class and picture below. Using a **PENCIL ONLY**, no colouring.

Create a drawing for 30-45 minutes. Remember, do not use your finger to blend, press lightly then build up your tones.



**This is what I will be looking at in your drawings:**

<b>Composition / layout</b>	Think about filling up the page and how you are positioning the objects.
<b>Tones &amp; Shading</b>	Are you showing different shades and shadows?
<b>Details</b>	Have you included details such as patterns and textures?
<b>Form &amp; Shape (3D qualities)</b>	Have you thought about how it will look 3D and the shapes of the objects
<b>Presentation</b>	Is it neat? Have you thought about how you are presenting your work
