**What should I already know?**

- Jesus is part of the Trinity of 'Father', 'Son' and 'Holy Spirit'
- Christians believe that Jesus is/was the Son of God
- Christians believe that Jesus is a role model for Christians and how they should live their lives
- The Bible is made up of the Old Testament (before Jesus' birth) and the New Testament (Jesus' life and teachings and the start of the early Church)
- The Gospels are the first four books of the New Testament (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) and tell of Jesus' life, death, teachings and miracles

**What will I know by the end of the unit?**

**Make sense of belief:**

- explain, with reference to the 'I am' sayings and/or the signs, what John's Gospel says about Jesus' true nature, and how this connects to Christian beliefs about what God is like
- explain how the Bible uses different types of text (for example, the Gospels) and language (such as metaphor) to communicate ideas about Jesus as God incarnate
- suggest meanings of the selected texts, explaining my ideas with reasons and evidence

**Understand the impact:**

- show how Christian worship reflects Christian beliefs in Jesus as God incarnate
- comment on the different ways in which Christians express worship of God

**Make connections:**

- reflect on the value of belief in Jesus as God incarnate for Christians in the world today
- comment on how far the world today could benefit from a saviour, offering my own reasons and justifying my responses
