# TASK 1

**LO: to complete an observation drawing of fruit.**

**TASK:** You will need an A4 piece of paper, a drawing pencil, rubber and sharpener. Layout some fruit (3-5 pieces), make sure it is overlapped with fruit in front of each other like the fruit we have drawn in class before and similar to the picture below.

Using a PENCIL ONLY, no colouring.

Create a drawing for **around 30 mins** (no longer than 45 minutes so set a timer on your phone!) Remember, do not use your finger to blend, press lightly then build up your tones. Don't worry about your background, if you have a fruit bowl you may draw it in that, however that is a bit more challenging, do what you think would be best for you.



**This is what I will be looking at in your drawings:**

<b>Composition / layout</b>	Think about filling up the page and how you are positioning the objects.
<b>Tones &amp; Shading</b>	Are you showing different shades and shadows?
<b>Details</b>	Have you included details such as patterns and textures?
<b>Form &amp; Shape (3D qualities)</b>	Have you thought about how it will look 3D and the shapes of the objects
<b>Presentation</b>	Is it neat? Have you thought about how you are presenting your work

**LO: to learn about the artist Antoni Gaudi and his style and inspirations.**

### **ANTONI GAUDI - Facts & Information**



Antoni Gaudi was born on 25th June 1852 in Reus, Catalonia, Spain. He studied architecture in Barcelona, Spain at the Escola Tecnica Superior d'Arquitectura but he was not a very good student. After five years, in 1878, Gaudi officially became an architect.

Antoni Gaudi did not like to draw plans for his buildings. He preferred to build 3D models of them to create a more accurate portrayal of what he was seeing in his mind.

During his lifetime, Gaudí worked in many styles. These included Orientalism, Neo-Gothic, Gothic Revival, Naturalism, and an overarching Modernism.

Gaudi disliked straight lines and angles because they don't often appear naturally. Instead, he based his design on the swirling curves of nature.

He died 10 June 1926(1926-06-10) (aged 73) Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain. He was hit by a tram.
