## Children in Need 2020

As you may already know, Monday 9 November is the start of this year's BBC Children in Need Appeal Week. Our school is excited to be joining with many others around the UK to participate in the fundraising programme.

Therefore, we will be taking part in some fundraising activities. This year, more than ever, is the time to join as a community and raise money for those less fortunate than ourselves and have a little fun together.

The Edward Peake School Council have discussed fundraising ideas within their meetings and with their form classes, and these are the activities that pupils can participate in.

The 'Come As You' theme was voted for by form classes. It is all about pupils embracing their identities, wearing whatever it is that makes them feel comfortable and expressing who they are on this Appeal day, whilst raising vital funds to support young people who need it most. Appropriate clothing and footwear for a day of education must be worn. Those choosing not to participate are to wear their school uniform or PE kit dependent upon their timetable.



The following exclusions apply, as with all our non-uniform days:

- no football tops,
- no cropped tops/hot pants
- no coloured hair
- no jewellery, make up or nail varnish

The Children in Need theme this year is 'Act Your Age', where pupils can complete an activity based on their age, combined age of their family, or combining their age and their friends. They then complete an activity that tallies to that chosen number, e.g. a pupil is 10 therefore they will complete 10 push ups. These activities can be completed in their PE lessons, but they will need to let their PE teacher know beforehand. Pupils can ask their family and friends to sponsor them remotely (due to current restrictions).

Once pupils have collected their sponsorship money, it can be donated to Children in Need via the School Gateway.

All other money donations will need to be paid via the School Gateway as we are not able to accept cash in school due to the current pandemic restrictions.

If your child wishes to buy a CiN cupcake, they will need to purchase it before/on Monday 9 November via the School Gateway, and order on Monday 9 November in their form class.

The pupils will also take part in activities throughout the week within their registration times to promote children's mental wellbeing.

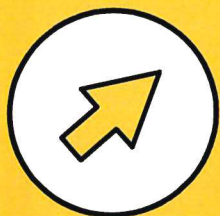

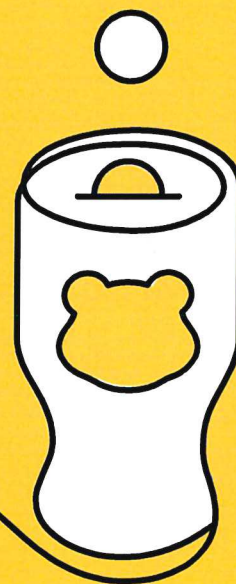

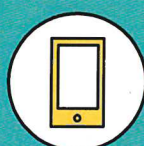
