Dear Parents/Carers

As we move through the winter season I am writing to update you with information regarding our emergency closure arrangements. Whilst every effort is made to keep the school open and maintain normal everyday procedures, the school has a duty of care to pupils, staff and the wider community. Please ensure you familiarise yourself and your child/children with the following information.

Emergency Closure before the start of school

If it is decided to close the school before the start of the school day (e.g. in the event of severe weather conditions), we will notify you in the following ways:

- Via text message on your mobile phone (with as much notice as possible)
- Via email
- Via the school's website <http://www.edwardpeake.beds.sch.uk>
- Via the school's social media platform on Twitter @Edward Peake
- Via the Central Bedfordshire Council website using their 'State of Schools' (SOS) system: <https://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/webApps/SOS/>. Parents can sign up for email alerts from the Schools Opening Status (SOS) system about the status of the school during bad weather conditions (i.e. open or closed). The SOS system also shows the status of the school transport routes, if the buses will be running or not on a particular route. It also has the ability to provide highways reports on the state of the roads. All these will be updated live on the website and email alerts will be sent to notify everyone who has registered. To sign up for this service, parents should visit the website below and register. The use of the SOS system will be in addition to the measures mentioned earlier. - Via the local radio stations, BBC Three Counties (95.5 or 103.8 FM/www.bbc.co.uk/threecounties) Chiltern Radio or Heart Radio

Emergency Closure during school hours

With regard to emergency closure during the school day (e.g. due to severe weather conditions, issues related to vital services, water shortage, flooding, heating failure, power failure, etc), parents/carers will be contacted via text message and email.




Up to date information
