
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Topic: Crisp Packet [materials Study]	Year: 9	NC Strand:	

What should I already know? Students would have built on their drawing skills in Year 8, where they progressed on their skills of the 5 tones, blending, form and spatial recession. Students have good knowledge of looking and understanding artists and expressing their opinions, they will build on this again this year while studying more contemporary artists where information is limited.
