What should I already know?

- The Bible is the Christian holy book and has a lot in common with the Torah and Qur'an
- The Bible is made up of different types of text (letters, history, prophecy...)
- Christians look to the Bible to teach them about what God is like

What will I know by the end of the unit?

- identify some different types of biblical texts, using technical terms accurately

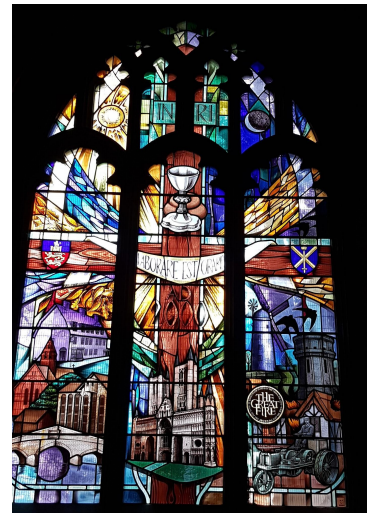
