



What should I already know?

- The Bible is the Big Story of the world, from its creation up to Judgement Day.
- The Old Testament and New Testament make up the Christian Bible
- The Old Testament tells of the creation of the world and the lives of people before Jesus was born
- The New Testament is the Gospels, together with letters and teachings of the early church from the birth of Jesus onwards
- The Gospels are the 'Good News' and tell of Jesus' life, teachings, death and resurrection

- to portray part of the Big Story as a picture, incorporating images from the Bible.

Vocabulary

Gospel	the good news of Jesus attributed to Matthew, Mark, Luke and John
New Testament	the last 27 books of the Bible - the four gospels, letters and the Revelation of John
Old Testament	the first 39 books of the Bible - books of history, law, prophecy and poetry
incarnation	a person who embodies in the flesh a deity, spirit, or quality
salvation	to be saved - deliverance from sin and its consequences
creation	the action or process of bringing something into existence
fall	the Biblical 'fall' is that of Adam and Eve leaving the garden of Eden
frieze	a broad horizontal band of sculpted or painted decoration, especially on a wall
