What should I already know?

- Islam is one of the Big Six faiths in the world
- Allah is the Islamic name for God
- The Islamic holy book is the Qur'an
- Muslims worship in the mosque
- Muhammad (pbuh) is the most important prophet in Islam

What will I know by the end of the unit?

I will be able to:

Make sense of belief:

- identify and explain Muslim beliefs about God, the Prophet and the Holy Qur'an (e.g. tawhid; Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) as the messenger, the Qur'an as the message)
- describe ways in which Muslim sources of authority guide Muslim living (e.g. Qur'an guidance on five Pillars; Hajj practices follow the example of Muhammad)

Understand the impact:

- make clear connections between Muslim beliefs and ibadah (Five Pillars, festivals, mosques, art)
- give evidence and examples to show how Muslims put their beliefs into practice in different ways

Make connections:

- make connections between Muslim beliefs studied and Muslim ways of living in Britain/Bedfordshire today
- consider and weigh up the value of, e.g. submission, obedience, generosity, self-control and worship in the lives of Muslims today, and articulate responses on how far they are valuable to people who are not Muslims
- reflect on and articulate what it is like to be a Muslim in Britain today, giving good reasons for their views

| Hajj | Islamic pilgrimage to Makkah, to be completed once in a lifetime if possible |
| Five Pillars | the rules for living carried out by Muslims (belief, prayer, charity, fasting and pilgrimage) |
| Shahada | belief in Allah as one God and in Muhammad (pbuh) as the messenger of Allah |
| pbuh | 'peace be upon Him' - a sign of respect said and written after important people such as prophets (Muhammad, Isa (Jesus), Ibrahim (Abraham)) |
| Salah/Salat | prayers - to be completed 5 times a day |
