# Songwriting



LO: To compose a song for a given purpose

Our new topic is songwriting and at this time of year, we usually work towards Children in Need as a charity to fundraise for in school.

Last Friday was Children in Need and a song is often chosen or written to help to raise money and to raise the profile of the charity in people's minds.

If we are going to compose a song, we need to think of what to include.

What do we need in a song?

Talk with a partner...



So... what did you come up with?

- Catchy lyrics with a message
- A melody

An accompaniment

What did you like about the songs?

Which part was the 'catchy' bit?

What was the message?



### Task:



With a partner, write some lyrics for a charity song.

- 1. Choose a charity (it doesn't have to be Children in Need)
- 2. What is your message?
- 3. Write at least 2 verses and a chorus in your GNB

Each verse or chorus should be at least 2 lines Long. It doesn't have to rhyme, but it would make it more 'catchy'.

Can you tell the class your charity and your chorus?

On lined paper, neatly write up your lyrics.

Remember to give your song a title - often this is either the first line of words or a line from the chorus.

If you finish, you could start the cover for your song.

#### Remember to put:

- The title
- The composers' names (your name and your partner's name)
- The charity (and maybe charity logo?)

LO: To perform a song as part of a group

**Lyrics: RAP or sing?** 

**Keyboard rhythm?** 

Melody: Keyboard, xylophone or metallophone?

Accompaniment: An ostinato (repeated pattern) that goes with your song.
