How does he fit the music accurately to the film?

Some of the techniques used are particularly effective when writing scary music or creating suspense before an event happens.

Have a look at the next slide for some ideas> Did you think of any of these?

- 'Jumpscare' silence then loud chord
- Chromatic notes (semitones)
- Gradually raise tempo
- Clashing notes
- Meandering melody leading to...
- High (string) sounds
- Short (staccato) notes rising up the scale
- Juxtapose low and high pitched ideas
