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2	To understand how faith can help people change their lives for the better	Starter: Parables sheet 'Stories with lessons' -fill in the gaps in pairs and discuss what the parable means. Who are the 'lost sheep' in this parable? Activities: Read through story of John Bunyan's preaching and prison life on ppt up to slide 17. Show the rest of the DVD. Discuss the story of Pilgrim's Progress. What was John Bunyan trying to say about life - his life in particular? Use 'Armour of God' sheet and Bibles to find out about Christian's armour. Plenary: How did John's life change for the better, despite spending time in prison?	ppt Stories with lessons Armour of God Bibles	Social: Can you work with a partner to solve a problem? 3	To reflect on how people use art, literature and music To express their joy and feelings. To understand the power of music in worship.	 Starter: Spot the hymn. Give pairs/ groups lines from well known hymns/songs for them to write the titles/first lines. (See worksheet) Discuss answers. How does music affect us when we worship? What does it help us to do? <i>Activities:</i> Which famous hymn is based on John Bunyan's story? Play you tube clip to listen to the hymn: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=txiKYvpuG9M Look at the words of the hymn and discuss the meaning. (You can do this with the original or modern words.) The two versions could be compared - do the modern words cover the meaning of the original? This could be done in groups with one large copy of a verse for each group to discuss and write on meanings. Groups could then feed-back results to the class. Children could then write a prayer, poem or song inspired by 'To be a pilgrim'. Can they write their own verse about the difficulties of life? 	ppt Hymn verses	Social: Can you work as art of a team?
