## Shropshire Visit 26 September - 30 September 2022

### Essential information for Parents/Carers

In reference to the year 7 trip to Manor Adventure in Shropshire we have compiled a list of essential information for Parents/Carers.

### **SUGGESTED KIT LIST: - TO BE CARRIED IN 1 SUITCASE AND 1 PIECE OF HAND LUGGAGE**

1. Sufficient (long) socks and underwear for 5 days (**NO TRAINER SOCKS**)
2. At least 3 **long-sleeved** t-shirts/shirts/blouses
3. At least 3 pairs of trousers/tracksuit bottoms wool or nylon pile is best (**NO JEANS**)
4. Light sweaters and at least 2 thick sweaters
5. Shorts for indoor activities
6. Swimwear for canoeing
7. Waterproof anorak/cagoule
8. Nightwear
9. Wellingtons (OPTIONAL- but very useful for underground maze)
10. Indoor shoes or slippers
11. Trainers/plimsolls (they are likely to get very wet and muddy on the assault course and canoeing). At **least** 2 pairs & then a separate pair for canoeing
12. Toilet bag - to include flannel, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap shampoo, comb, hairbrush, 1 or 2 press on sanitary towels for girls.
13. 2/3 Towels
14. Waterproof trousers (OPTIONAL - but very useful)
15. Hat/cap/gloves/scarf (Weather pending)
16. Walking boots (OPTIONAL)
17. Coat

### **OTHER ITEMS NEEDED:-**

1. Sleeping bag and pillow case (*In suitcase if possible*)
2. Torch and spare batteries (named) Optional but very useful for night activities.
3. Travel sickness tablets for the journey home
4. Several strong waterproof bags for packing wet clothing and muddy boots
5. Small activities for the journey/free time e.g. books, packs of cards, small game, notebook
6. reusable bottle for drinking water.

## **LOST PROPERTY**
