Instrumental Lessons

At Edward Peake, there are a variety of instrumental lessons available to pupils. Lessons are 20-30 minutes long, dependent upon an individual or a shared lesson. The visiting peripatetic teachers will invoice you directly for lesson fees which will be approximately $\pm 10.00-12.00$ for an individual lesson. There will usually be 10 lessons per term and the teacher will invoice you directly once the lessons have been set up. Some funding may be available for children who qualify for pupil premium.

The instruments available are: guitar, drums/percussion, flute, clarinet, saxophone, recorder, trumpet, French horn, tenor horn, euphonium, trombone, violin, and piano. If there is sufficient interest, we could also offer singing lessons. Apart from piano and drums, there are some instruments that pupils can loan from school or from the teacher delivering lessons, so it is not necessary to buy an instrument in the short term.

Please indicate on the form below which instrument(s) your child is interested in learning and return it to the school office. The appropriate teacher will then contact you.

Music clubs would usually take place at lunchtime and some after school rehearsals such as steel band and school production. When it is possible to run these clubs, we will inform you of the days and times.
