French Trip 20 March – 24 March 2023

Essential information for Parents/Carers

In reference to the year 8 trip to France we have compiled a list of essential information for Parents/Carers.

<u>ESSENTIALS & SUGGESTED KIT LIST:</u> - TO BE CARRIED IN 1 SUITCASE AND 1 PIECE OF HAND LUGGAGE: -

- 1. Passport and/or travel visas, permits, as required.
- 2. UK Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) for European trips (please bring into school prior to the trip)
- 3. Snacks for the journey
- 4. Spending money in a purse/wallet
- 5. Any personal medication (liaise with staff re: safe storage and keeping)
- 6. Refillable drink bottle
- 7. Notepad & pen
- 8. Small day bag/rucksack
- 9. Towel Not provided by the accommodation
- 10. Sufficient socks and underwear for 5 days
- 11. Sufficient clothing for 5 days and evenings (check local temperatures at time of travel)
- 12. Swimwear
- 13. Nightwear
- 14. Sturdy outdoor walking shoes with a good grip
- 15. Indoor shoes e.g. slippers or flip flops
- 16. Waterproof outdoor jacket with a hood

OTHER ITEMS NEEDED: -

- 1. Wash bag & toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, brush/comb etc.)
- 2. Ear plugs (handy for shared rooms!)
- 3. Watch/alarm clock
- 4. Labelled plastic bags for wet/dirty/spare clothes
- 5. Small torch
- 6. Travel adaptor plug
- 7. Travel hairdryer
- 8. Book/e-reader/playing cards.

Mobile phones, electronic equipment, computer games, jewellery, valuables, iPads and laptops <u>MUST NOT</u> be brought on the trip and will not be covered by insurance in the event of damage, loss or theft of items.

LOST PROPERTY

From previous experience we have found that by the end of the week many children have forgotten which clothes they have brought with them. To ensure that the children take all of their belongings home, can you please make a list of everything that you pack and enclose the list inside the suitcase. It is **ESSENTIAL** that all clothing is named so that we can ensure any lost property is returned to the correct person.

MEDICATION

Pupils may only bring medication **prescribed by their G.P.** and this must be in the original packaging.

All medication should be clearly named and labelled with instructions. These are to be handed in **before Friday 16 March 2023** and will be looked after by a member of staff for the duration of the trip. If medication cannot be handed in before this date because it is needed over the weekend, please let the office know prior to the day of departure.

GLOBAL HEALTH INSURANCE CARD.

Please ensure that you have a valid UK Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) or European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). GHIC/EHIC Cards are free to obtain via the official website:

EHIC or GHIC is not a replacement for travel insurance. The school have purchased travel insurance. The production of these cards, should the need arise, will prevent parents receiving invoices from hospitals. Each healthcare system is different, and in some countries, you'll need to pay to have treatment. A GHIC lets you get medically necessary state healthcare in Europe at a reduced cost or sometimes for free. If your EHIC is still in date, you do not need to apply for a new GHIC.
