Dear parent/carer,

As your children are settling into the academic year, I wanted to write to you regarding your school's planned change from the three-tier model of education to the two-tier model from September 2024, as part of our Schools for the Future programme.

At this stage the transition process is well underway, and this year will be your child's school's final academic year in the three-tier system.

In working towards your school's transition to either a primary or a secondary in September next year, we are busy procuring contractors to carry out necessary building works required to expand schools and are working with school leaders to ensure that all other aspects of the transition are supported.

Applications are now open if your child is year 8 and due to transition to upper school in September 2024. More information on school admissions is available here: <u>https://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/admissions</u>

If you are considering your options regarding this transition then you will be welcome to attend any opening evenings hosted by the schools and more information on these, including dates and times, will be available directly from schools.
