As we have entered the darker winter months, it is imperative that your child is visible when travelling to and from school. This guide will offer some **quick** tips to **minimise** the risk of walking/ scooting/ cycling to and from school.

Pedestrians:	Cyclists:
 Wear something brightly coloured. Wear something reflective at night. Fluorescent armbands can be worn over bags and coats. Keep on the footpaths on your journeys to and from school. Be aware of your surroundings - take earphones out before and whilst crossing the road. 	 Ensure your bike is equipped with reflectors at the front, rear and on your wheels. White lights at the front and red lights at the rear of your bike. Reflective tape and flashing valve caps are also a good idea. Fluorescent bands around ankles will make you more visible to road users. Bright and reflective clothing is a must.
