As part of their studies on the 'Amazing Adaptations' topic in Humanities, Year 6 will be taking part in an educational visit to Cambridge Botanical Gardens on the following days:

- **6HK and 6TH** - Friday 14 June 2024
- **6AB, 6KD and 6SC** - Monday 17 June 2024

As well as enjoying fantastic enrichment activities in the museums, year 6 will also have the opportunity to observe real world examples of themes discussed in lessons.

For the visit to the Botanical Gardens pupils will need to attend school as normal with the coaches scheduled to depart at 9am. Your child will need to wear/bring the following:

- Full school uniform,
- Trainers or comfortable walking shoes.
- Sunscreen
- A packed lunch (unless you specified a school provided lunch).
- An additional drink
- Coat/ hat - depending on the weather.
- An additional snack.
- A pen and pencil.

Children may bring a camera but are **NOT** permitted to take **mobile phones**. Any phones brought in on the day of the trip will be kept at school and returned when we arrive back at Edward Peake, as usual.

We are actively seeking any parent/carers volunteers who will accompany and support a teacher and class group during the visit. Any interested parent/ carers will need to make contact with the front office by Friday 26 April 2024.

We kindly request a voluntary contribution of £15 per child to support the entry and transport costs.
