Energetic Edward Peake week is due to take place from 1 - 5 July 2024. It is a chance for us to celebrate our pupils' sporting endeavours and offers extra opportunities for all pupils to take part in individual and team sporting activities and events.

Sport for All Day marks the culmination of the house sport calendar. All pupils will compete for their house in a number of different sports during the day. As usual, they have had the opportunity to select their events during their house assembly this term. The activities range from traditional athletics events and team sports to more diverse activities such as board games, bowls and outdoor adventurous activities and problem solving. For the day to run smoothly, all pupils (including those who are currently injured) will need to come to school in their Edward Peake PE kit (navy blue or black jumper, black shorts, PE polo shirt, socks and trainers). They will also need a water bottle to keep hydrated throughout the day and sun cream and a hat to ensure they remain comfortable in the sunshine.

The Fun Run will continue to take on the newer format due to the large number of pupils we now have in school. Each school house will start and participate in the event at different locations around the course. The new route will allow pupils to count their laps and convert them into kilometres. We hope that as well as taking part on the day, pupils will also get as many sponsors as possible. Every contribution, however big or small, is really important to us and will be gratefully received!

To make the Fun Run even more of an occasion, the children can choose to run in fancy dress rather than their PE kit; additional house points will be awarded for the best costumes. (Please remember that costumes must be appropriate and suitable for running outside.)

On the day of the Fun Run children will be able to come to school in their PE kit but fancy dress must be brought to school in a named bag.

We look forward to seeing you and remind all parents that no photographs or video recordings of children are permitted at the event. The week will be celebrated via the main school X account.
