


Community safety What does it mean to you?

STOP. LOOK. LISTEN.

Stop, Look & Listen, before you cross the road.

Use your eyes, Use your ears, before you use your feet.





You **MUST** stop at the crossing and walk bikes and scooters across. Look both ways inside the school and towards the road before crossing. This is a safety requirement.







Water safety What does it mean to you?



Fight your instinct to thrash around.

Lean back, extend your arms and legs.

If you need to, gently move them around to help you float.

Float until you can control your breathing.

Only then, call for help, swim to safety or continue floating until help arrives.

Always keep alert around water!


