Please find below a brief outline of the curriculum:

English	In English, we will be using the story called ' <b>The Stone Boy</b> '. We will be looking at the story in close detail. We be using the story to write a wide range of non-fiction. We will be writing dairy entries, letters and newspaper articles. In grammar will be focusing on fronted adverbials sentences and inverted commas, as well as continuing our work on the different word classes.
Maths	We are going to be using all our times table knowledge:
	Multiplication and Division

	the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times
	one-digit numbers.
	- Solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and
	division.
RE	We will be continuing our Lent unit and moving onto Holy Week on the last week of term.
Science	In science, we will be looking at <b>rocks</b> . We will be comparing and grouping together
	different kinds of rocks based on their appearance and simple physical properties. We
	will be describing in simple terms how fossils are formed.
PE	Tuesday: Tag Rugby
	Thursday: Fitness
History	We will be learning about the STONE AGE.
Art	We will be learning about Winslow Homer. Learning different techniques that Winslow
	Homer uses. We will be using watercolours to add colour to our pictures.
