#### **Expectations**

<u>Spelling homework</u> - The children will be sent home with spellings to practise; these will go out on a Monday and will be checked in school.

Reading - It is expected for children to spend 10-15mins (minimum) reading at least 4 times a week at home. Reading is vital to developing children's imagination, creativity and to help with the development of phonics; the children will continue to access phonics every day and will be assessed regularly. We understand that some children are finding these phonics readers easier than the old books. Please rest assured that we are assessing every week based on the sounds learnt and practised within our phonics lessons.

<u>Phonics</u> - **Week beginning 6**<sup>th</sup> **June** the children will undertake their phonics screening check. They have worked hard for this and have made great progress. Please continue to read with them every night and practise the real and alien workbooks sent home.
