COVID Catch Up Funding

£6939 has been spent on tutoring via a company called Connex Education. A tutor came in during the Summer term 2021 twice weekly and delivered targeted support to those children assessed as being most in need.

School led tutoring allocation

This funding replaces COVID catch up funding and can be used to pay school staff additional hours to deliver targeted support to pupils. Including the surplus carried forward from our COVID catch up funding, our remaining allocation is £12738.50. This funding has been allocated to covering the cost of:

- Placing an additional teacher into Year 5 until the end of the Summer term (4 mornings per week) allowing the class to receive more targeted, smaller group teaching in English and Mathematics.
- Providing 'booster' sessions for all children in Year 6 in Reading and/or Maths over and above the daily classroom allocation. These are planned for a delivered by staff known to the school to children before or after school.

Pupil premium recovery funding

This funding is specifically for those children eligible for pupil premium funding. The allocated funding will contribute towards HLTA salaries who will provide targeted support.

In all instances, impact of this funding is measured through close tracking of the attainment and progress of pupils. Assessments at the point of entry into support provide a baseline for this, and careful ongoing monitoring, through both formative and summative assessment is used to track and establish the impact of the funding.
