Last Tuesday we had a Y5/6 rounders tournament. This was played at All Souls against 3 other schools. The team played amazingly, winning 2 out of the 3 games, but unfortunately they didn't make it through to the next round.

On the same day after school, a netball and girls football match took place against St Christophers. Although they played well the netball team lost their match. The football team won their match 5-2. Well done both teams!

On Wednesday last week our cricket team took part in the Catholic Cricket tournament. They managed to get through to the final against Scared Heart but despite their best efforts lost a very close match.

On Thursday lots of children went to Warwick University Track to compete in the Catholic Schools Athletics. We came back with three medals – Livia (Y6) Silver 800m, Leo (Y6) Bronze Throwing and Millie (Y3) Silver Sprinting.

Finally on Friday last week, Y5 and 6 took part in a Tag American Football competition. The children gave it their all and managed to reach the semi-finals. They had a great start in this and went 12-0 up however the school who had travelled all the way from Nottingham finished strong and pulled it back to win 14-12. Super effort everyone.

On Tuesday this week our Y4/5 girls rugby team took part in their Finals Tournament. They played against 8 different schools, although they didn't win they were extremely unlucky as they played fantastically throughout the whole tournament.

After school on Tuesday, a football team from Y3/4 and Y5/6 played against St Christophers. For many of the children, this was not only their first time playing football for the school but their first time playing in a competitive match. Even though they didn't win the result was not important as it was great to watch them play with huge smiles on their faces.

Today all children in school took part in a 30-minute fitness challenge to help raise money for new playground equipment. They all showed great effort, determination and courage to complete the challenge. Well done everyone!
