# Young Voices - late registration on Wednesday

Those children attending Young Voices on Tuesday evening will have until 10am on Wednesday to get their morning registration mark; a lie in may be needed! We hope the choir have a fabulous evening!

## Attendance

Following the significant number of absences during the final two weeks of term, the school's overall attendance for the year has down dropped to 93.3%. This is something which now needs to rise this term and, whilst we do not want children who are poorly in school, we encourage parents who are unsure as to whether their children are well enough to bring them in to school; we will always contact parents if we feel that a child is unwell and needs to go home. Like with ourselves, when you are not 100% you often feel worse first thing in a morning and at night and many children who don't feel well first thing pick up during the morning.

A huge disappointment last term was the significant number of children who are late for school each day. At its worst there are as many as 18 children late on a given day and the daily average seems to be an average of around 6 children late. In order to reduce this, we now want to understand more fully the reasons why children are late and so, from next Monday (9<sup>th</sup> January) parents of children who are late for school will be asked to complete a form confirming why their child was late. This form will be emailed to the parents of children who have arrived late each morning and will be required to be completed each time a child is late. Please note that any child arriving after 8:45am is late and are recorded as so, even if adults are still positioned on the gate and it is open. We cannot reiterate enough the importance of children arriving at school on time as it not only results in them being better prepared for the day ahead but also reduces stress and anxiety.
