Although no year group fell below 93% during the week ending 17th March which is positive, only one year group achieved over 96%, which was Year 3. Well done to them. At 20, the number of lates this week is the highest total in over a month. Please be reminded of the importance of arriving on time for school each day: being just a few minutes late not only results in children missing important learning and consolidation opportunities – as activities are planned by teachers from 8:30am each morning – but also does not set children up adequately for a successful day. There are 113 children across the school who have not been late on a single occasion this year – well done and congratulations to them.

On Monday, eight Year 2 children took part in a Gymnastics competition held at Tribe Gymnastics. They each performed two routines, one floor and one vault which they have been practicing for the last couple of weeks. Unfortunately, we don't know the result of this competition yet as there were more heats taking part throughout the week.

The first of our County Finals took part on Monday afternoon. Our Year 4 speed stackers travelled to Leamington to compete against 15 other schools from Coventry, Warwickshire and Solihull. Despite their best efforts and lots of practice at home we didn't quite finish in the top three. The exact result is to be confirmed. After patiently waiting for the opportunity to take part in the staff challenge at the end of the event, Mr Youson didn't disappoint and came fourth!

Tuesday was a day for rowing with two County Finals taking place in the morning and afternoon. The first competition was an all-boys row; they had to race both individually and then in a relay. This was extremely competitive and very, very tight from start to finish. There were 16 schools taking part overall and they finished in a fantastic 8th place. The afternoon saw 4 more children from Year 6 take part in a competition called 4 U Row. The format was very similar to the morning event with individual and team rows. The team all rowed fantastically and all achieved PBs in their rows. This meant that out of the 16 schools they finished in an incredible 2nd place.

On Wednesday, Years 5 and 6 took part in the Sports Hall Athletics County Final. This time they were competing against 7 other schools in various different races and field events. Again the event was extremely competitive, but despite this, we finished in a superb 4th place with 240 points, just 14 points from 2nd place.

On Thursday, our Cross Country runners took on lots of other schools from across Coventry and ran for one mile around Bablake Fields. Despite the torrential rain, they gave their absolute all and we now await the final results.

We are immensely proud of everyone this week. Behind the scenes at All Souls a huge amount of planning and preparation goes in to ensuring the children are able to take part in sports events. We are very grateful to Mr Youson, Mrs Rae, Miss McGaffney and Miss Greenway as without them this week would not have been possible.
