## **PTA Pledge**

Dear Parent(s) and Carer(s)

On behalf of the PTA, I would like to wish you all a belated happy new year and to share our PTA pledge with you all, detailing what we will be fundraising for over the coming year.

The school have advised that due to the south facing position of the playground, the children feel they would benefit from having a large sun canopy so that during warm weather, they can take their learning outdoors where possible, whilst being protected from direct sunlight.

The canopies would also facilitate outdoor picnics / lunchtime activities and generally be of great use for sports and fun days alike.

(Equally - and given this is the U.K. - they would also provide shelter from light rain and wind, allowing outdoor learning / play to continue even in these conditions!)

We are all aware of the positive correlation between mental health and emotional well-being and being outdoors in natural sunlight and this is an area the school works hard to engender whenever possible.

We estimate that these canopies will cost in the region of £15,000, so there is still a lot of money to raise!

We wanted parents and carers to be aware that the events we have planned over the next year will all be raising funds towards the purchasing of these canopies, so we hope you will support us work towards this target together.
